Fishers Community Center Amenities

- Free amenities for everyone including walking track, indoor playground, and Sahm's Community Café.
- Membership model with additional amenities including access to 2 pools, 3 gyms, 2 group exercise studios, cycle studio, large fitness floor and childcare services.
- Home of Fishers Health Department.
- 3-acre Dog Park located on the campus, will have monthly membership.
- 4 Multipurpose rooms



An inclusive Community Center for **ALL** Fishers residents!

- Accessibility has been front of mind in design. Fishers Councilwoman Cecilia Coble, along with Fishers Committee on Disability volunteers and City staff toured Turnstone in Ft. Wayne in 2022, a best-in-class facility designed to empower people with disabilities to achieve their highest potential.
- Based on 2023 input from FACD, the Community Center will feature auto sliding entry doors, a powered adult changing table located in a universal locker room adjacent to the pool, and adaptive exercise equipment.
- We will have a partnership with Outside the Box Inc., a day program with a mission to empower people with intellectual disabilities toward Personal Growth, through Education, Self-Discovery, Leadership Development, and a Customized Career Path.
- Facility will also include handrails into the zero depth pools, a water wheelchair, pool lift chair, universal locker rooms, sensory room in childcare, and help alarms throughout.

Highlights from Review

- **Accessible Parking:** Met requirement of 8 spaces, all van accessible (5'x 8' striped zone adjacent). Additionally have 2 spaces in employee parking lot and 2 in the Dog Park parking lot.
- **Passenger Loading/ Unloading:** Drop off/ pick up lane is at grade with bollards 4'9" apart.
- **Walking Lanes:** Have ADA tabs at all crosswaks.



- **Bathrooms:** ADA stalls, accessible counters, paper towels and soap dispenser.
- **Drinking Fountains:** All have accessible height with water bottle fillers.

- **Dog Park Water Fountains:** Designed by Willoughby, have accessible height option with water bottle filler.
 - **Main Entrance:** Auto sliding doors.
 - **Membership Turnstyle:** ADA width, motorized openers, timer adjusted to be a comfortable timing for all guests.
 - **Stairs:** Fixed seating underneath to ensure safe headspace and cane detectable.



- **Adult Changing Table:** Recommended Pressalit model. In accessible universal locker room, next to pool. Have 24” clearing on short side; best practice is 36” turn radius on all sides.
- **Sinks:** All public sinks have accessible angled skirts.
- **Tip & Roll Temporary Bleachers:** Nothing in market for ADA accessible shoulder to shoulder seating. Contacting manufacturer to explore options.
- **Playground:** Waiting on more information from Play Power to evaluate accessibility.
- **Membership Services Desk:** Would like input on design.
