Also the Business Matching Grant program has not yet been approved for 2024 but if approved, the application window is Oct. 2 – Dec. 15. Ross noted that we are still on schedule for a June City Hall/Arts Center opening. The new Koda Witsken mural at Alderman on Hwy 37 may be our largest mural yet. We do anticipate that the FACC continues to receive their \$ 60,000 that has been earmarked from City Council in 2024.

d. FACC 2023 Business Matching Grant, Cycle

- Whistle Drive Project – Document – Voting Item

Bre King presented the Whistle Drive Sculptures. The Grant request is for \$17, 500. Rachel and RQAW representatives answered questions. Drew had several questions/comments about materials, maintenance, lighting. The activated location is away from 116th St. The material is hollow concrete placed on crushed stone and it will be possible to sit or climb on the 4 leaves. The sculpture will be surrounded by a path and lush plantings.

Jocelyn asked for a Motion to approve the design. Drew Braley made a Motion to approve, seconded by Angie Frazier. The Motion was approved, 4-0.
