The January 13, 2026 meeting of the Fishers Arts & Culture Commission was convened at 4:30 p.m. by Angie Frazier.

In attendance: Angie Frazier, Mark Williams, Drew Braley, Neil Stevenson. Cecilia and Rasha were not in attendance. Also in attendance, Ross Hilleary, Christy Cashin, Kay Prange, Les Reinhardt, Marissa Deckert.

Mark Williams made a Motion, seconded by Drew Braley, to approve the Consent Agenda, which contained Minutes from the December 18, 2025 meeting.

Elections:

Angie made a Nomination for Drew Braley as Chairperson, seconded by all. The Nomination was approved, 4-0. Drew Braley Made a Nomination for Mark Williams as Vice-Chairperson, seconded by all. The Nomination was approved, 4-0.

Fisher Parks and Public Relations updates:

There were no formal updates – however we discussed the many concerts, the Holiday Tent and Library events, and pulling together 2026 event schedule.

Community & Economic Development updates: Ross presented Financials, showing a remaining balance of \$123,000 with no applications in 2026. Mark made a Motion to approve, seconded by Neil Stevenson. The Motion was approved, 4-0. Could Signal Box painting be accomplished with a Lottery? The fund has \$17,400 which will cover 7 boxes at \$2000 each, plus \$3400 for maintenance on existing boxes. Paint or vinyl wrap are allowed and the City will put out the RFQ through the IAC, Noblesville Creates, Fishers' social media. Les will look at previous examples by 3/1.

Goals for 2026:

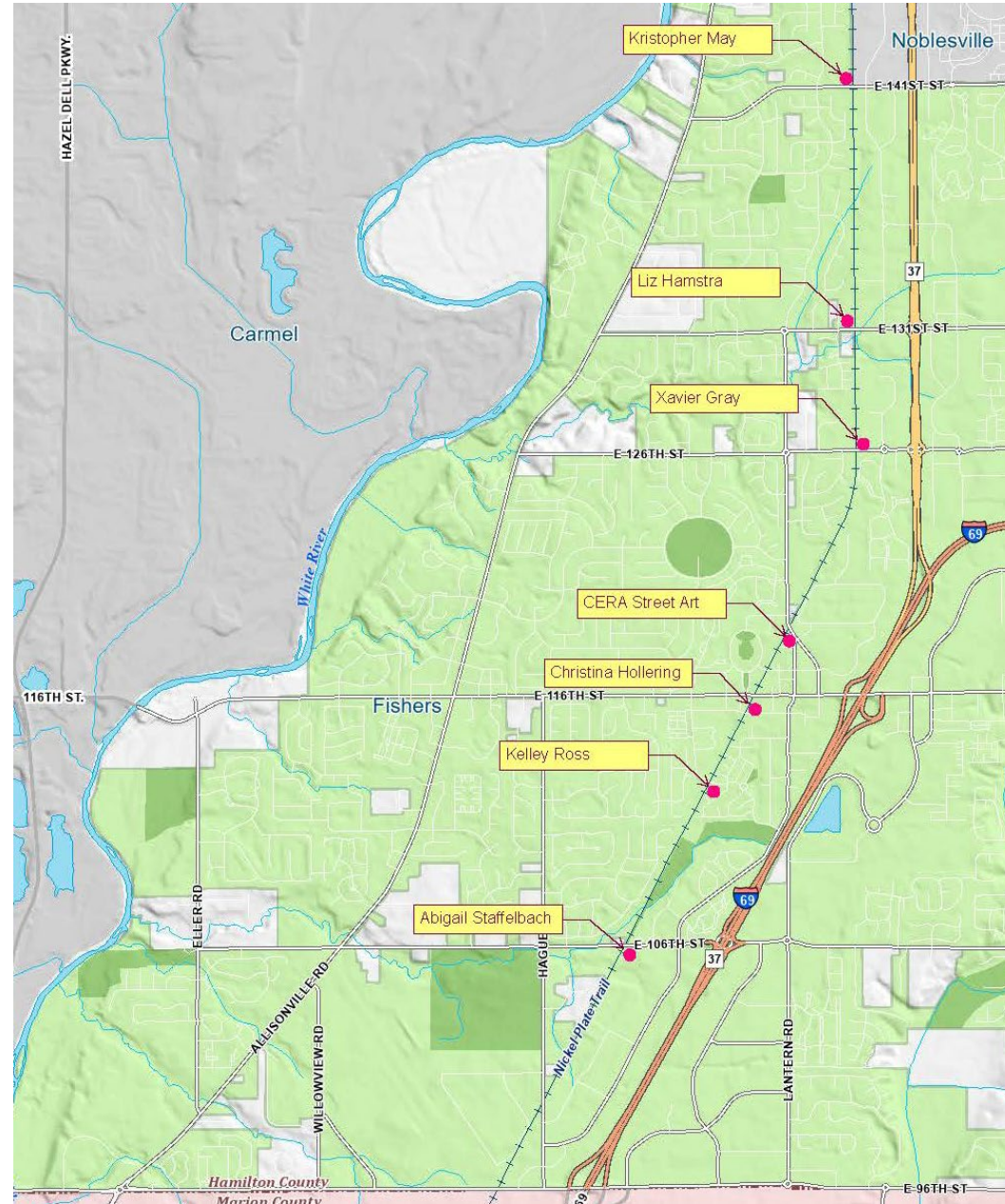
Update the A&C master plan and re-evaluate.

OVERALL CONCEPT: The junction at 106th & the Nickel Plate Trail is home to both Cheeny Creek and The Maker Playground, creating a unique space where creativity, nature, and innovation meet.

TOP: Orange background with monarch butterfly & uplifting wraparound text that reads, "discover. imagine. explore. create. innovate. wonder. tinker. collaborate. revel. be."

MAIN BOX: Blue background with raccoons fabricating creative projects in mediums including woodworking, tile/mosaic, and 3D printing. A pair of racoons put their skills to the test, installing a hand-made sign for the community.

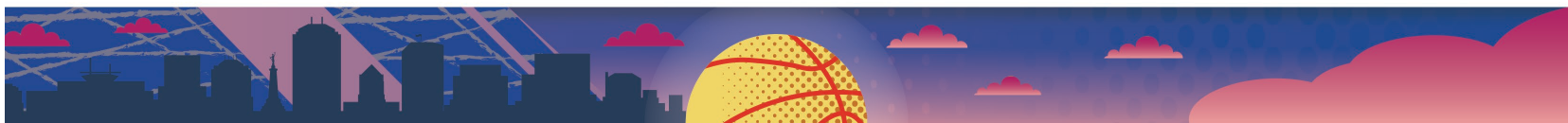

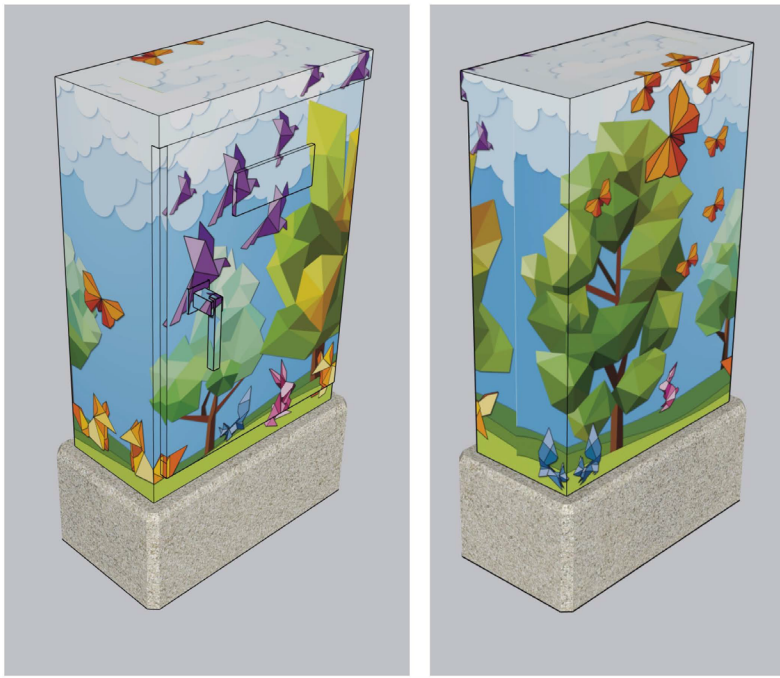












Signal Box Art Installation

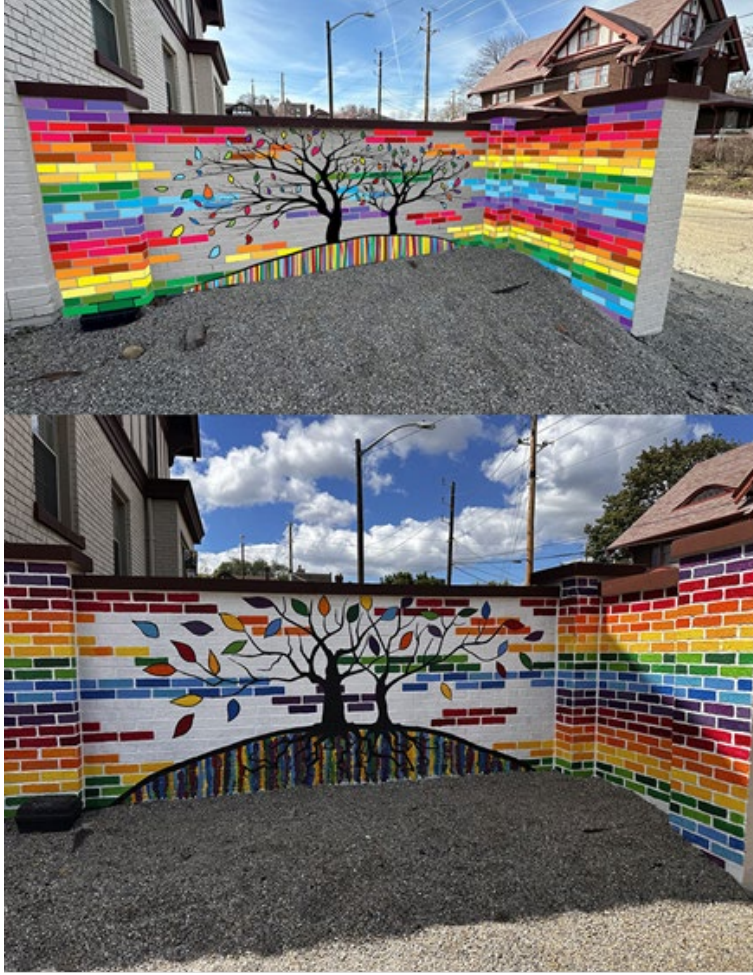
