2. Regular Items - 2027 Budget Discussion

- **Mike Reuter went over Property Tax and Local Income Tax.**
- **2025 Assessed Evaluation of Property Tax went through significant property tax reform. Property Tax base will reduce over time to the city. Business Personal Property Taxes have also been reduced for the city.**
- **Due to the annexation of some Fall Creek Township, the fire department contract income will be reduced to the city.**
- **We did get the Maximum Levy fixed for 2026, with a 6% increase. For 2027 there will be an additional 3% increase.**
- **Elliott Hultgren explained which departments will be at the next budget meeting.**
- **Todd Zimemrman asked about update on Community Center**
- **Cecilia Coble asked about road, sidewalk, and lite poles update.**
- **Bill Stuart asked about the flood update and FEMA.**
